

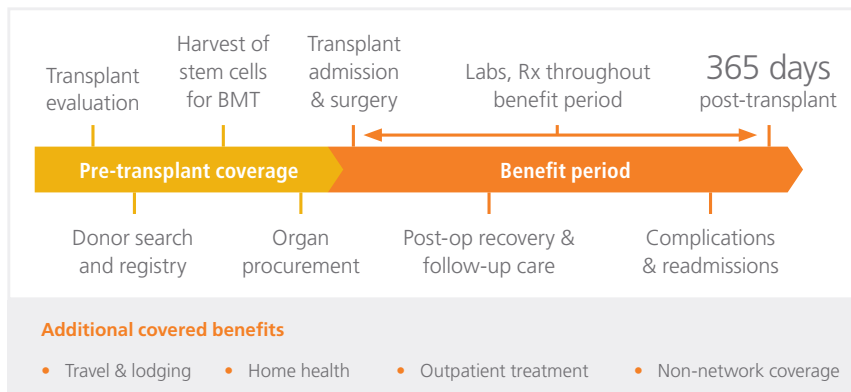
Managed Transplant Program

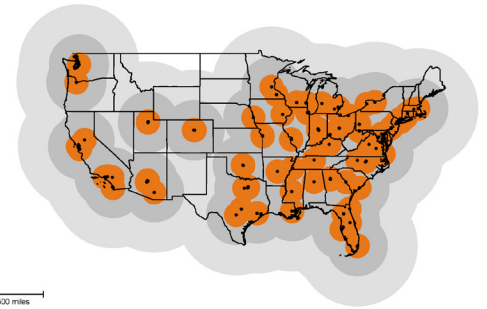
